

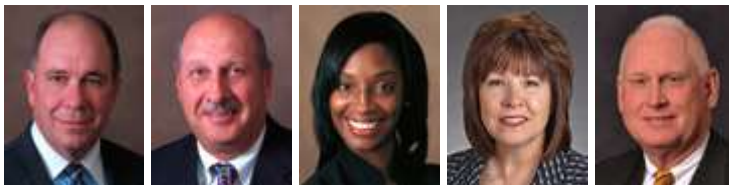

Exxon Mobil Corporation was successfully represented at trial by DRI members [E. Paige Sensenbrenner](#), [Glen M. Pilié](#), and [Michelle D. Jarvis](#) of [Woolf, McClane, Bright, Allen & Carpenter, PLLC](#) in Knoxville, Tennessee. The jury returned a verdict in favor of the defense after a two-week trial. The plaintiff contended that she developed papillary thyroid cancer as a result of exposure to naturally occurring radioactive material in oil field tubulars.
